Fleshly vs Spiritual weapons (1 Samuel 17)



if so be the LORD will be with me, then I shall be able to drive them out, as the LORD said.

And Caleb drove thence the three sons of Anak, Sheshai, and Ahiman, and Talmi, the children of Anak.

It isn't always possible to kill, that is, entirely get rid of, our giants: but they must not prevent us attaining our inheritance in the Kingdom. But this is only possible with God's help.
